Product Development Strategy

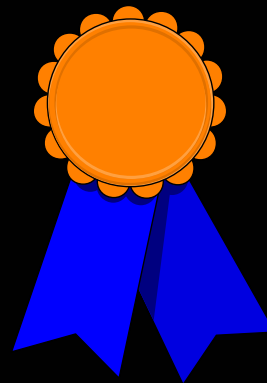
- Optimised for OpenVMS

- Maintenance Releases every 3-4 months
- New Feature Releases every 18-24 months
- Examples:
 - Rdb 7.0.6.3 January '02
 - Rdb 7.0.6.4 June '02
 - Rdb 7.0.6.5 September '02

 - Rdb 7.1.0.2 April '02
 - Rdb 7.1.0.3 July '02
 - Rdb 7.1.0.4, 7.1.0.5, December, '02

- Improvements in scaling for NUMA systems
- Next Generation Alpha System
 - Rdb EV7 certification in progress (<90 days from FRS)
- Benefit: Significant performance improvement

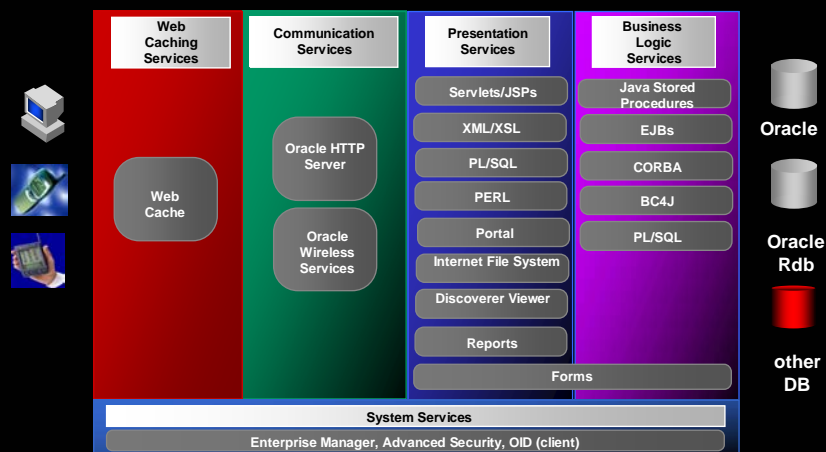
VMS V7.3-2

 - Rdb Certification
 - Baselevel (pre-field test) testing in progress
- Circa Q3CYO3
- Benefit: Upgrade with confidence to take advantage of the latest VMS enhancements.

DECdtm XA Interface Project

- HP's DECdtm/XA Gateway means
 - DECdtm-compliant components participate with XA-compliant components
 - DECdtm becomes XA-compliant RM
- Rdb supports DECdtm 2PC so it can now participate in XA transactions
- Benefit: True distributed transactions that update multiple Rdb and Oracle databases.

Tape Library Support

- Oracle Media Management version 2.0 API support begins in Rdb version 7.1.1.0
 - Used by leading librarians: ABS, Legato, Veritas
- ABS tested and supported¹
 - Other support possible
- Parallel backup plan files supported
- Benefits:
 - Same tape library support for OpenVMS and Rdb backups
 - Tape library support for parallel backups

¹ Testing by HP will be completed before ship date

Oracle Database Compatibility

- Extended LOB support : including new Oracle RDBMS native types: LONG and LONG RAW
- Oracle 9i OCI updates
- PL/SQL Support
- Native JDBC driver (in Beta)
- Benefits:
 - Easier portability of code between database systems
 - Better support for web services, web applications

Oracle Enterprise Manager

- Enterprise Manager will be able to
 - Discover Rdb databases
 - Detect events and react to them
 - Schedule jobs
- Production release of the Oracle Rdb Cartridge for OEM 9i (currently in beta)
- Benefit: Events and jobs from same console for both Oracle Rdb and Oracle Database.

Query Optimizer

- Improved estimation
- Improved use of bit map indexes
- Benefits:
 - Better choices when multiple indexes could be used
 - Same queries result in fewer IOs

Quality

- Develop a random query generator
 - a) does the query compile?
 - b) does the query generate the same results as previous version [7.1.0.4 vs. 7.1.0.3, or 7.1 vs. 7.0]
 - c) compare results with Oracle Database
- Benefits:
 - Detect poor strategies before we ship
 - Detect incorrect results before we ship

Recovery Performance Enhancements

- Redo & Undo
 - Additional prefetching of Database, AIJ and RUJ
 - Additional asynch I/O
 - Benefit: Faster recovery from process or node failures
- RMU /RECOVER
 - Performance improvements with optimized AIJ
 - Benefit: Faster recovery from database failures

Row Cache Improvements

- Snapshots in Cache
- 64 bit row cache: Address existing cache-size limitations
 - ~33 million row cache size limit removed
 - Eliminate current 32-bit addressing limitations of cache data structures
 - Move from P0/S0 to P2 address space
- Benefits:
 - Vastly larger caches
 - Improved performance
 - More existing applications get write benefits from Row Cache
 - Uses OpenVMS shared memory performance features

- Cross Compilation
 - COSI 100%
 - KODA 85%
 - DBMS 90%
 - Rdb 85%
- Updating Cross Tools and Libraries, etc. Weekly
 - Each release improves
 - Considered V1.0 at this point

FCS Release Plans

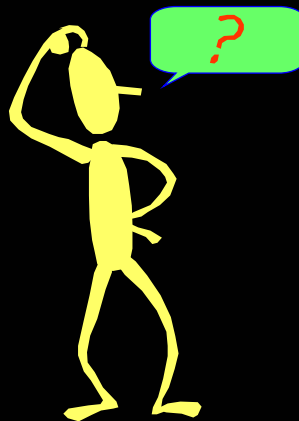
- This is a delta schedule
