- Easy to handle
- GUI
- Scaleable
- Access
 - serial line
 - via terminal server
 - remote access (via RAS)
- Scheduled runs



Design considerations (2)

- Online and offline monitoring of performance data
- Separating data collection and data view
- Interface to Microsoft standard products (Excel)
- Interface to PerfDat and T4
- Quick implementation

Components of the tool

- Two images
 - DStat data collector
 - DStat monitor
- COM based VB applications with extensive use of API-calls
- Totally independent
- Single threaded
- Multi instances





